# Security of supply in the region of SE Europe

#### requires large scale diversification of sources and supply routes

The region (excl. Ukraine) is dependent on Russian gas by ≈ 60% i.e., 22-23 bcm (2021)



- CEE & SEE are traditionally dependent on Russian gas with few alternatives.
- SEE and the Balkans are among the few European gas markets with strong growth prospective (≈ 10% 2021-2030)
- The only alternative infrastructures in operation today are TAP and the LNG terminals in Revithousa and Krk.
- The only fully independent infrastructures are the LNG Terminals.

Alexandroupolis and Thrace LNG
Terminals are set to satisfy a significant
part of the new demand as well as the
need for diversification of the supply
sources.







# Alexandroupolis LNG Terminal is the most important new project for Energy Security and Diversification in the region which is being currently IMPLEMENTED

Infrastructure complementarity is key for the security, independence and development of the markets of SE Europe. Alexandroupolis LNG Terminal operates in harmony and complementarity with IGB and all other existing & planned regional gas projects.

#### **New infrastructures:**

- ✓ support consolidation of the markets, liquidity and enhance trading optionality
- ✓ facilitate gas penetration, reduce isolation and consequently reduce overall energy costs

#### The LNG terminal in Alexandroupolis:

- enhances regional penetration and alternative supply and route options for the whole region
- ✓ strengthens security and independence of supply
- ✓ supports the transition to a cleaner energy mix

The timely completion of the planned new regional infrastructure projects is of critical importance









#### **Thrace LNG Terminal:**

#### The Project will operate in complementarity with the Alexandroupolis LNG terminal

- The Thrace LNG Terminal in Northern Greece, offshore Alexandroupolis, is promoted by the Greek company Gastrade, established in 2010 with the objective to design, develop, operate and manage the infrastructure for the reception, transmission and distribution of natural gas.
- The Project comprises the FSRU with storage capacity of 170,000 185,000 cbm LNG and a maximum regasification rate of 650,000 Nm³/h which corresponds to approximately 6 bcm/year and the permanent infrastructure (mooring system, pipeline, etc.) which connects the FSRU to the Greek National Natural Gas Transmission system and/or TAP. The FSRU will be stationed approximately 15 km SW of the town of Alexandroupolis in NE Greece at an offshore distance of approximately 4.5 n.m. (8 km) from the nearest shore.
- The Project's license for an Independent Natural Gas System has been approved by the Regulatory Authority for Energy on 27.04.2022.
- The Project is candidate to be included in the "REPowerEU" facility.
- Commercial Operation Date can be realised within 2024.
- Estimated Investment Cost: 510 ml. Euro




