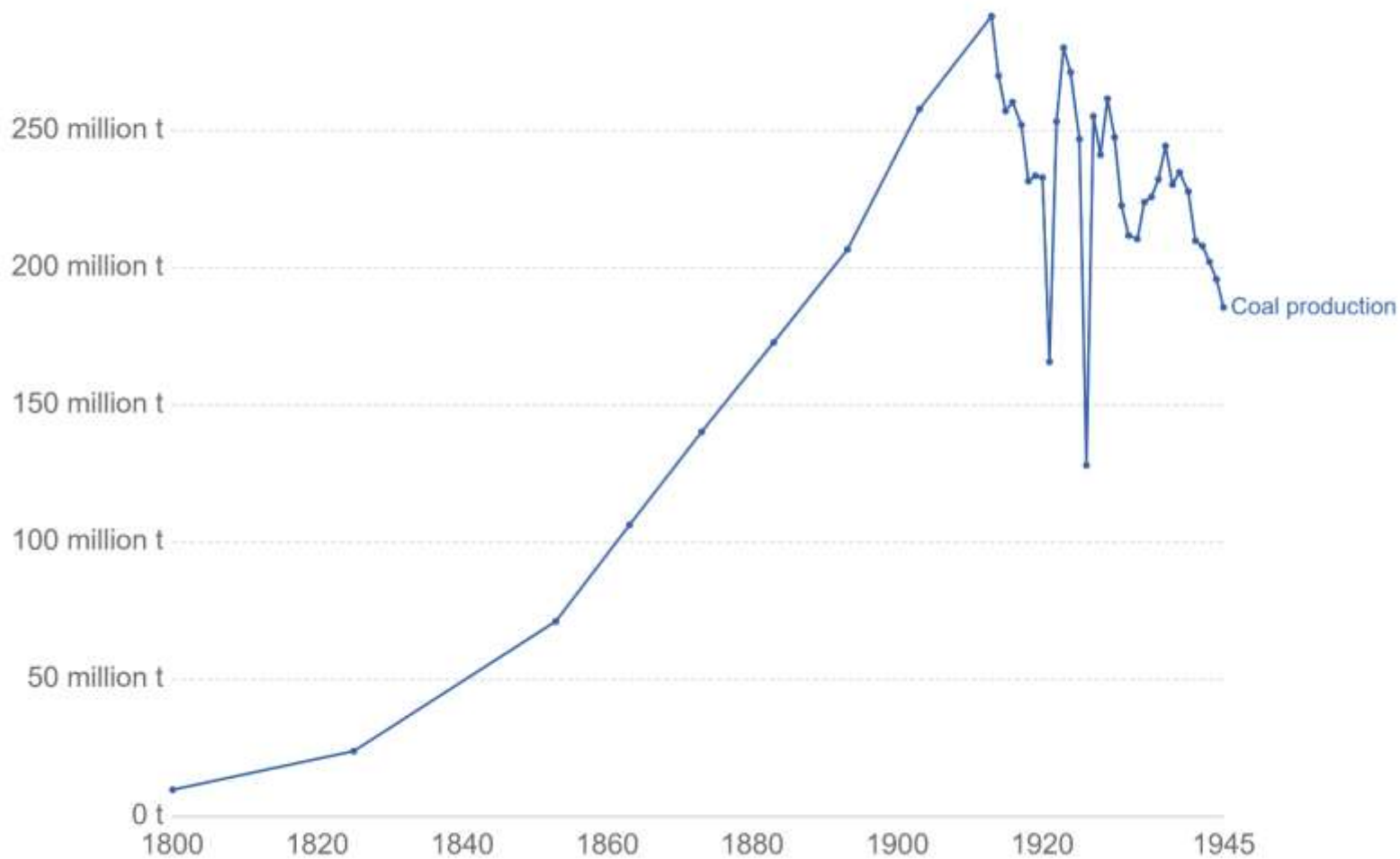

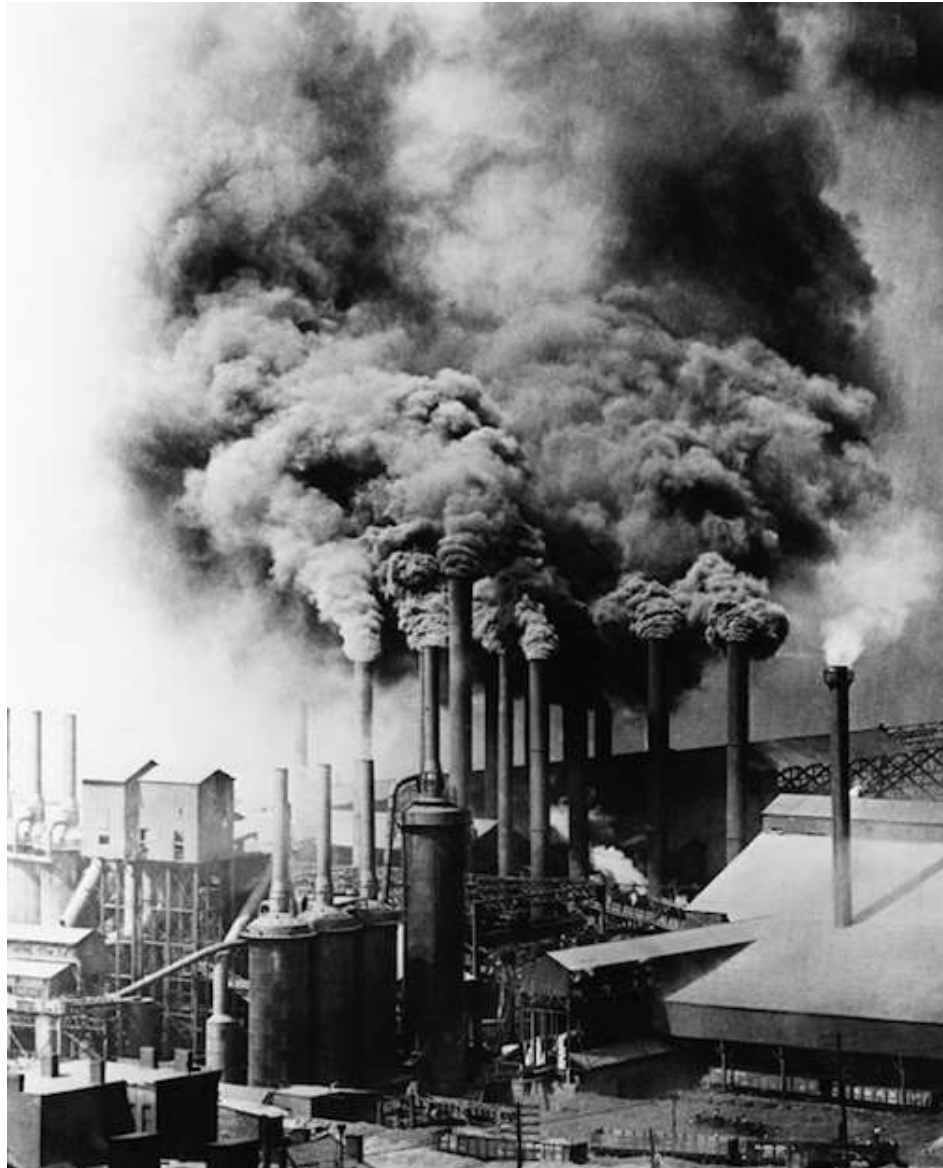
Coal production and imports in the United Kingdom

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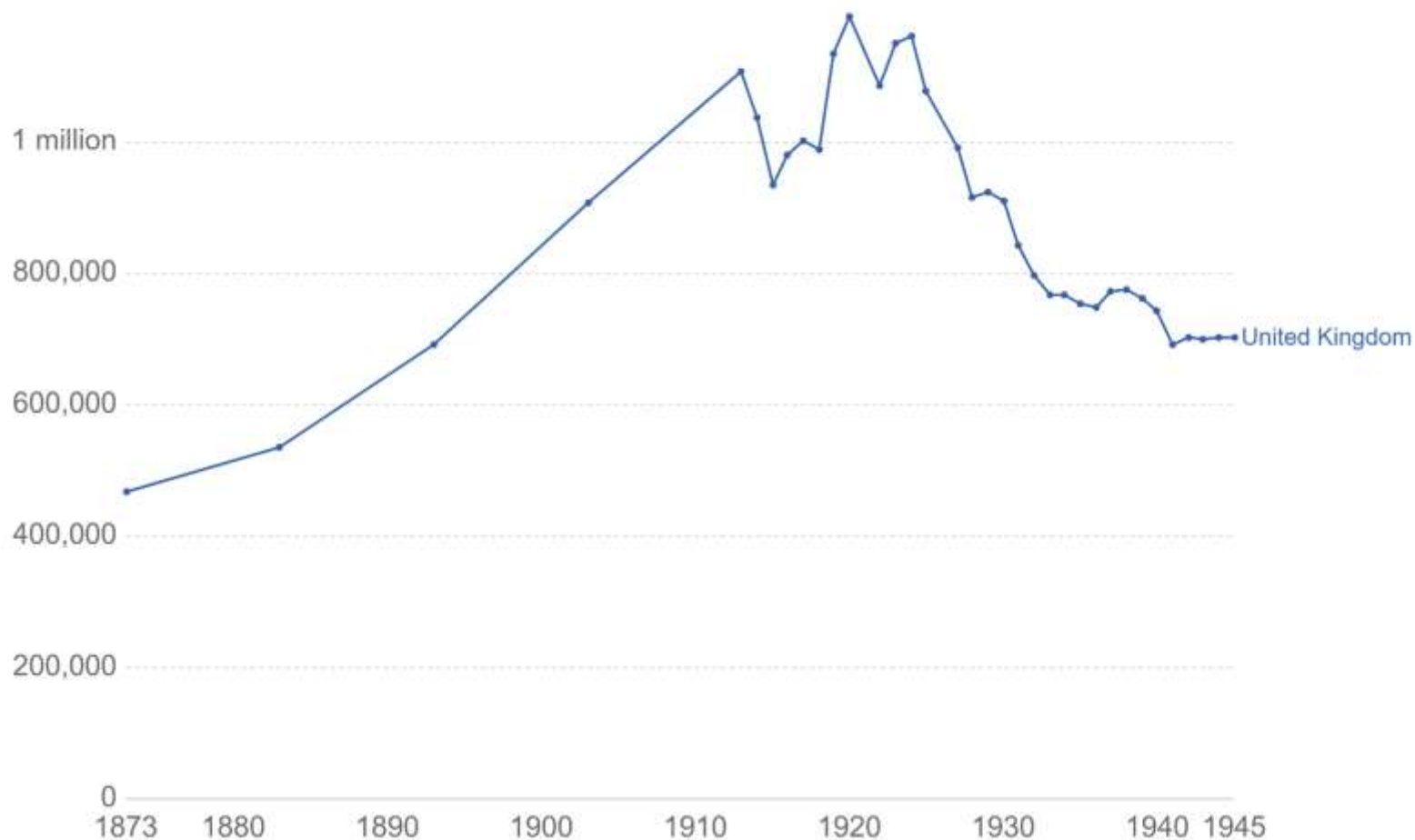




Employment in the coal industry in the United Kingdom

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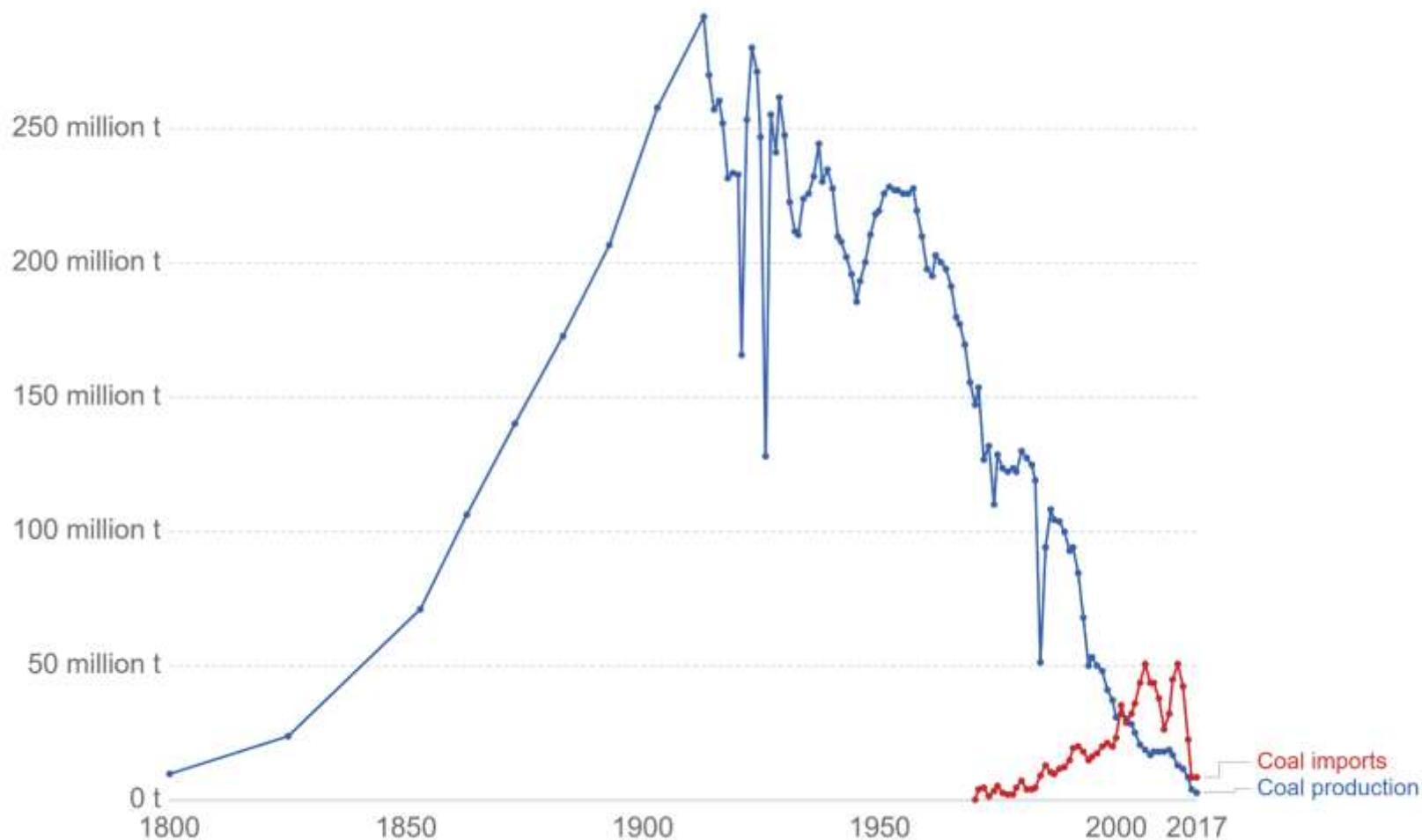

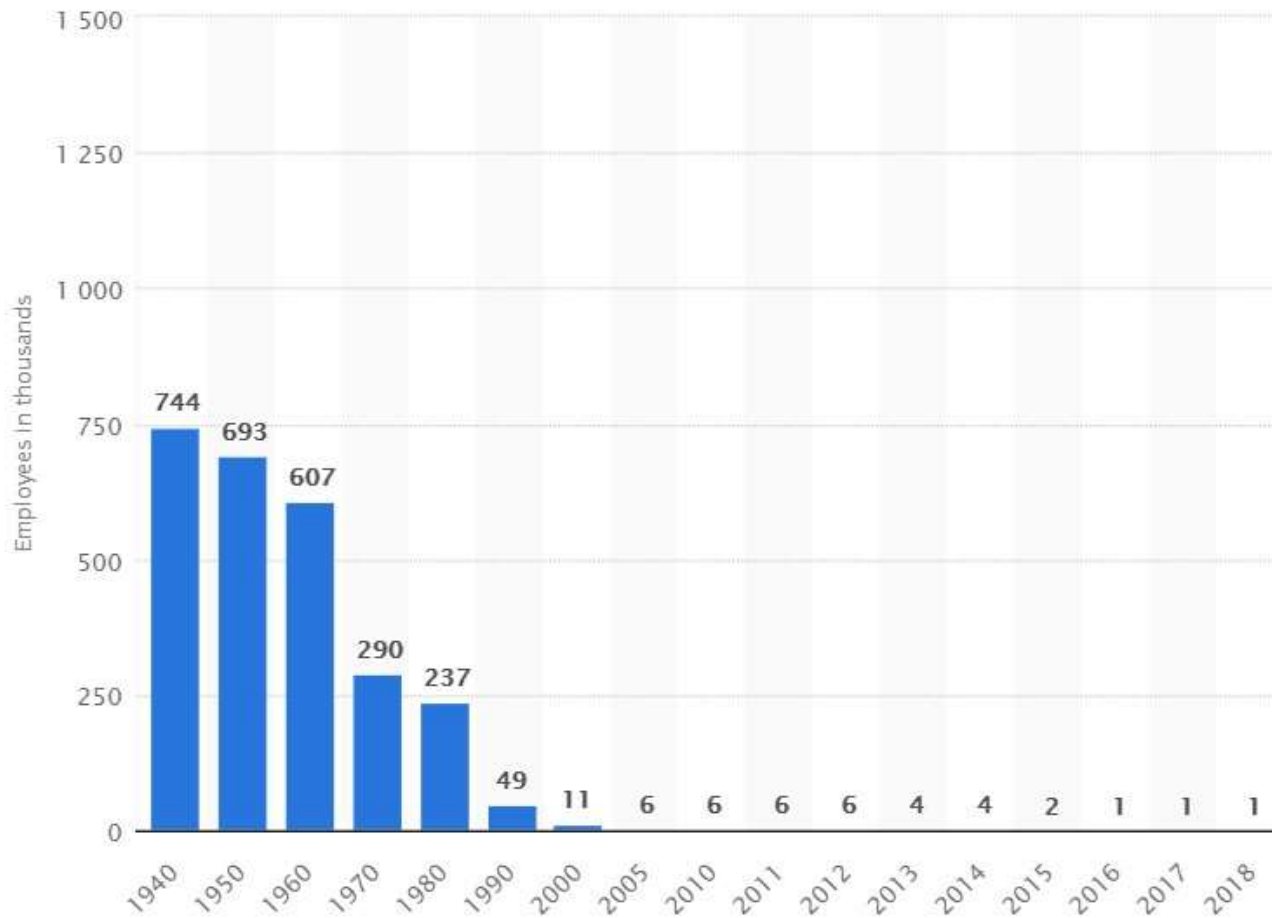
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Number of people employed in the coal mining industry (in thousands)

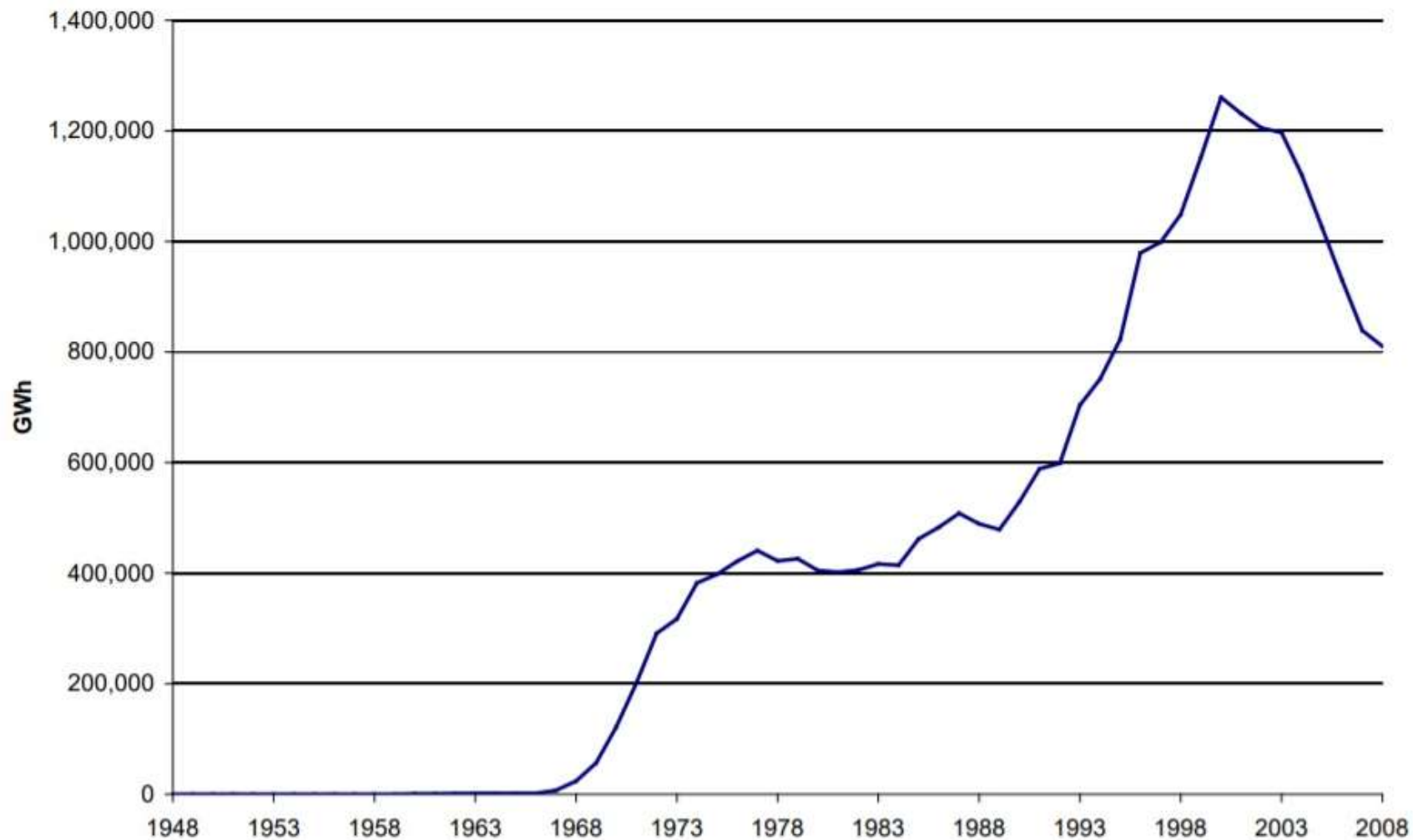

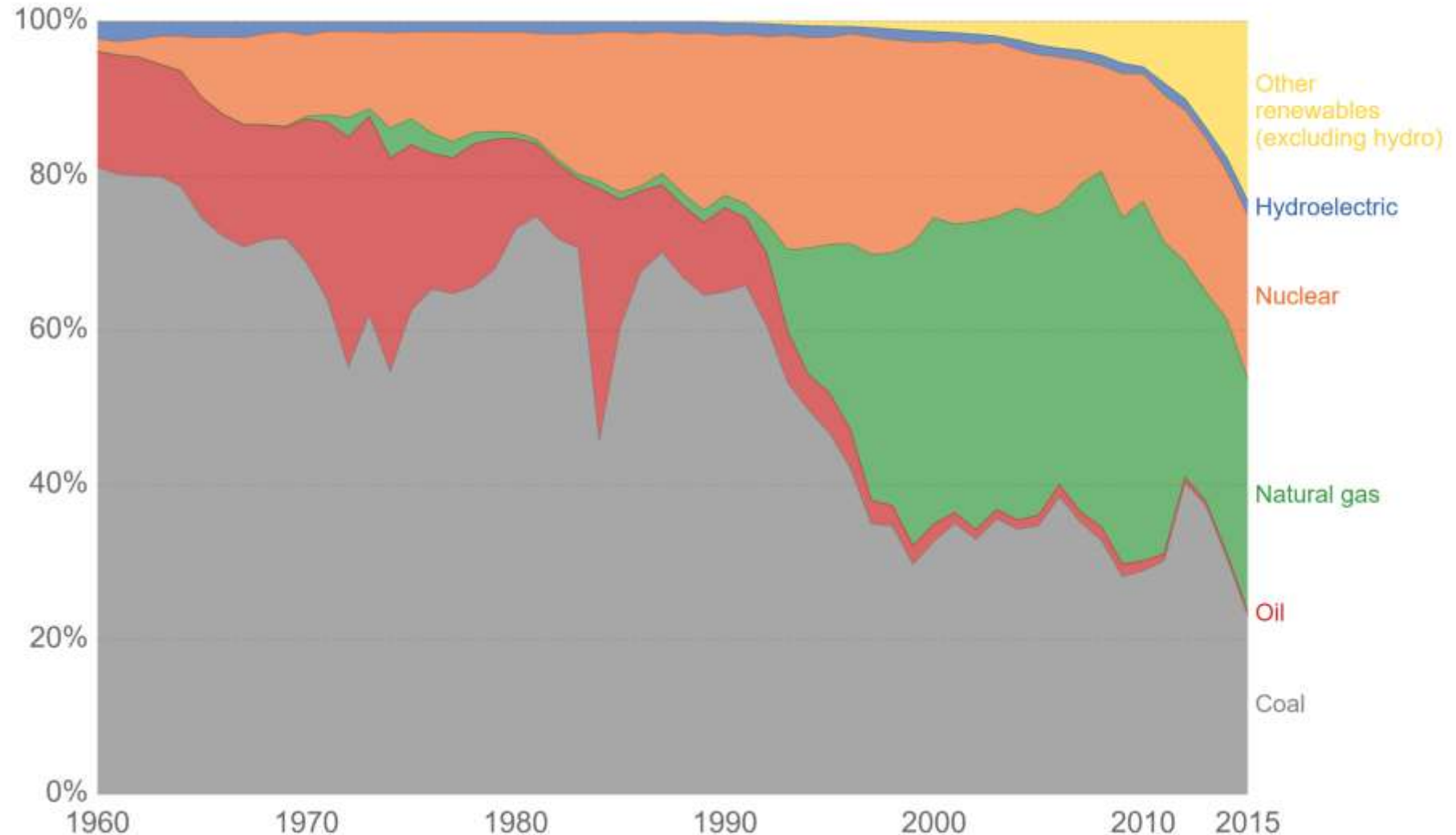




Gas production in the UK
