SESSION 2 – PRESENTATION OF IENE'S STUDY

Kostis Oikonomopoulos, Petroleum Geoscientist – Research Fellow IENE



Before joining IENE as a Research Fellow in September 2023, Kostis Oikonomopoulos spent over six years at HEREMA SA, Greece, where he served as the primary seismic interpreter and petroleum geoscientist, specialising in prospectivity analyses and regional understanding. In this capacity, he also coordinated two important oil and gas Lease Agreements ("West of Crete" and "Southwest of Crete"), offering technical subsurface expertise on licensing matters, stewardship and monitoring of licence work programmes

and activities. Also, he assisted in compiling and reviewing contracts regarding seismic acquisition and processing projects and at the same time supervised and managed HEREMA's data repositoty as well as its digitization and restructuring.
