


Company Information


Investments 2005 - 2018 (€ mio)


Further Investments in RES:

The EU has set strong climate and energy commitments for the years 2020:

- 20% cut in greenhouse gas emissions (from 1990 levels)
- 20% of EU energy from renewables
- 20% improvement in energy efficiency

The EU has set stricter commitments for the year 2030:

- At least 40% cuts in greenhouse gas emissions (from 1990 levels)
- At least 27% share for renewable energy
- At least 27% improvement in energy efficiency



 Such target implies total installed RES capacity of 13.300 MW and in particular 7.500MW of wind farms, 3.000MW and 2.500MW of solar parks.


Interconnection Projects (according to the development plan of ADMIE):

Interconnection of Cyclades

- ✓ 1^{st} phase under construction → Interconnection of Lavrio-Syros and Syros with Paros, Mykonos and Tinos → Completion during 2017
- ✓ 2^{nd} phase under construction → Interconnection of Paros-Naxos-Mykonos → Operation during 2018 or 2019 (latest)
- \checkmark 3rd phase \rightarrow 2nd submarine cable of Lavrio-Syros \rightarrow Completion till 2022

Interconnection of Crete

- ✓ Phase I under licensing → 150 kV AC interconnection of 2x200 MVA Crete-Peloponnese
- ✓ Phase II under pre-licensing \rightarrow DC interconnection of 2x350 MW Crete-Attica
- ✓ The cost savings for Common Benefit Services is estimated at approximately 300 mio euros annually.
